JULY 22 - 27, 2018

6 DAYS

*Enjoy spectacular sunset and sunrise at Uluru (Ayers Rock). Hold a koala. Visit Victorian College for the Deaf, the oldest deaf school in operation since 1860, in Melbourne. See the penguin parade at Phillip Island.*

### JULY 22 • • •

We fly west to Uluru (formerly known as Ayers Rock). Walk around the sacred site of Uluru. Evening sunset of Uluru. Stay at Yulara. *D*



### JULY 23 • • •

Rise early to see the sunrise of Uluru. Learn about Aborigines at the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre. Then fly to Brisbane. Stay in Brisbane for 2 nights.



### JULY 24 • • •

Get the opportunity to hold koalas and see kangaroos, wombats, dingos, Flying Fox bats, crocodiles, Tasmanian devils, and world's most dangerous birds: Southern Cassowaries. 1.5 hour drive to Surfer's Paradise for some beach, shopping and leisure time. Return by evening for dinner at South Bank. [B](#)



### JULY 25 • • •

Fly down to Melbourne in the morning. By late afternoon, we head down to Phillip Island to see the penguin parade at dusk (as they arrive back to shore from spending all day feeding in the ocean). Stay in Melbourne for 2 nights. [B,L](#)



### JULY 26 • • •

A morning grand tour of Melbourne. See the colorful bath houses at Brighton Beach. Visit Victorian College for the Deaf, which is the only remaining deaf school in Australia, and in operation since 1860. Free time in the afternoon, which would include exploring graffiti alleys, going on the skydeck at Eureka Tower and/or visiting the Immigration Museum. An amazing dinner experience, which would take about 3 hours. [B,D](#)
